

# YOUTH CENTER RULES AND REGULATIONS

## HOURS OF OPERATION

5:00-8:00 PM

1. The center is for residents and their guests only (excluding residents or guests of rental units of one year or less). The Recreation Center is not for use by renters.
2. All youth must sign-in when they use the center. An emergency contact telephone number **has to be given, this is MANDATORY.** The contact person should be easily accessible, if needed quickly.
3. The youth must share use of the T.V. and other recreation center equipment.
4. Children under 8 years old must be accompanied by an adult. The Attendant is **NOT** responsible for supervising children under 8 years old.
5. The youth are not allowed upstairs in the Community Center or fitness center. This is an insurance issue as well as a safety measure.
6. Youth are not allowed to use the phone in the Recreation Center for personal use. They may call for a ride home. There is no long distance service on the phone. The phone is primarily used for emergencies.
7. Due to the variety of PG movies, only those found to be acceptable by the attendant will be allowed to be shown. No movies can be brought from home.
8. If it is busy night, the youth are only allowed 30 minutes each on the Nintendo Game.
9. At the discretion of the Recreation Center Attendant any unruly youth can be asked to vacate the Recreation Center. Normally the three warning rule will apply when dealing with unacceptable behavior. Persistent offenders may be banned from the BHVA Recreation Center.
9. Absolutely no alcohol is allowed in the Recreation Center.
10. Due to the location of the Recreation Center, the Recreation Center Attendant cannot supervise the basket ball court or the playground. Parental supervision is required for children under 12 years old.
